Day of show entries allowed 1 hr. before trial starts if runs are not filled, for \$10.00 more per run. Saturday Sept. 24th will be an AM and a PM trial. Roy Sage will be judging the AM trial. Joan Carrillo will be judging the PM trial. Judges meeting for the AM trial at 7:30 am. (cattle to be run 1st). Judges meeting for PM Trial will start at 1:00 pm.

Classes: Cattle 3 hd. Cattle @ \$40 per run

Sheep 5 hd. Dorpers @ \$35 per run

Geese 5 hd. Mixed br. @ \$20 per run

Divisions: Started, Open, Advanced, Novice, Junior Handler

(Junior handler & Novice ½ entry fees per run)

A total of 35 runs for AM and 35 runs for PM Trials will be accepted.

Prizes: Ribbons for 1st thru 4th place. Prizes each trial for: 1st places; HIT Cattle; HIT Sheep; & HIT Geese.

Special Prizes: For all 3 trials. A total of combined scores for all 3 trials.

Most Promising Started Aussie; Most Promising Started Other Breed; High Combined Scoring Goose Dog; High Combined Dog.

Most Promising Started Aussie: A combination of scores with highest total in all started classes to be winner for ASCA registered Aussies. Scores combined from all Started classes in all 3 trials. Tie broken by time.

Most Promising Started Other Breed: Any breed except aussies, running in the started division are eligible for this award. A combination of scores from all 3 trials in started classes in all divisions totaled. Tie broken by time.

High Combined Scoring Goose Dog: The dog must run in all 3 trials in a goose class. Highest total to get a monetary award. Tie broken by time.

High Combined Dog : A total of all scores from all 3 trials. All dogs running in the trial will be eligible. Tie to be broken by time. Highest to get a monetary award.

Sunday, September 25th. Same fees as runs on Sat. A total combined of no more than 45 runs .

Roy Sage to judge cattle and geese. Sheep will be judged by Joan Carrillo.

If you enter all 3 classes of stock for each of the 3 trials in any division with the same dog, you may enter for \$260.00. (a savings of \$25.00).

The entire trial is run in the Krouse Barn. To expedite , help is appreciated setting up the geese ring after AM sheep. That ring will be 80 X 90.

Please enter fairgrounds at gate (#5). If you pre-entered your name will be at gate 5 and admission will not be paid. The Krouse barn is at the far end and back of the fairgrounds. Parking & entry is free to competitors only. Camping is allowed overnight, but no amenities. Super 8 motel is close. # 541-664-5888. .
